Report on Standing Committee on Overseas Admissions 2017

- 1. As of 31 December 2017, there were a total of 23 applications for the admission of overseas counsel to practise as a barrister in Hong Kong on an *ad hoc* basis, as compared to 32 in 2016. Of the 23 applications, 7 were for criminal cases.
- 2. This year the Standing Committee consented to 21 applications, 7 of which were criminal cases. It opposed 2 applications, both civil cases.
- 3. The total number of applications allowed by the Court was 23 (of which 7 were criminal cases).
