

Report of the Special Committee on Pupillage and Limited Practice 2010

The Special Committee on Pupillage and Limited Practice is responsible for processing applications and answering enquiries about the rules, practice and procedure in respect of pupillage and admission.

During the 12-month period from 1 December 2009 to 30 November 2010, the number of pupils who either have completed or are serving pupillage amounted to 126 (which is 15 more than that in the previous year). 56 of them have been admitted as barristers, of which 49 were admitted in 2010. The Special Committee has processed a total of 418 applications which were received at different stages of the pupils' training.

I am indebted to the members of the Special Committee, Selwyn Yu SC, Jennifer Tsui and Edwin Choy for their prompt and invaluable advice and contribution.
